<p><b>Council Fire</b> 439 Dundas Street E. 416-360-4350</p>	<p>*did not open their 7/7 overnight emergency shelter in September 2006 that would normally have operated until May 2007 *City funding was declined</p>	<p>-loss of <u>60+</u> overnight emergency shelter spaces 7 nights per week (male and female)</p>
<p><b>All Saints Church Community Centre -Drop-In</b> 315 Dundas Street E. 416-368-7768</p>	<p>*future of the drop-in program uncertain *City staff reported in Fall 2006 that the Church was not reapplying for funding for 2007 *negotiations continue between the City and All Saints * Feb. 2 - announcement that drop-in will continue to summer 2007</p>	<p>-potential loss or shrinkage of services or hours in day shelter used by men and women who are homeless/underhoused 5/7 -potential loss of capacity for 100-200 people per day -unknown long-term impact on access to free phone, washrooms Street Health nursing services including ID clinic, etc. -potential to cause overcrowding of existing day shelter services such as the Friendship Centre</p>

<p><b>Knox Presbyterian, (Out of the Cold)</b> 630 Spadina Ave. 416-921-8993</p>	<p>*did not open their Tuesday night Out of the Cold program in winter 2006-7 for youth ages 16-25 *report that most of the kids (sic) they have served have found housing</p>	<p>-loss of <u>40</u> overnight shelter spaces for youth (male and female)</p>
<p><b>60 Richmond Shelter</b> (Dixon Hall) 60 Richmond St. East 416-304-0018</p>	<p>*scheduled to close in 2007 *proposed redevelopment of site for housing</p>	<p>-loss of <u>70</u> overnight 7/7 shelter spaces (male and female)</p>
<p><b>110 Edward Street</b> (City of Toronto Emergency Shelter and Referral and Management Centre) 110 Edward Street West 416-338-4766</p>	<p>*scheduled to close in 2007 for redevelopment of the site for housing *although City is planning to relocate, the location is not yet announced *City has not guaranteed they will replace the total number of shelter spaces</p>	<p>-loss of <u>80</u> overnight 7/7 shelter spaces (male and female) including daytime shelter -loss of <u>40</u> overflow spaces (male and female) -loss of access to referral site</p>

<p><b>Salvation Army-Riverdale</b>  312 Broadview Avenue  416-465-6970</p>	<p>*reduction from 60-45 beds after a city audit.  *capital repair costs huge  *scheduled to close in June 2007  *implementing a monthly reduction of spaces until closure</p>	<p>-loss of <u>15</u> overnight 7/7 shelter spaces (male)  -closure will mean loss of <u>45</u> more spaces 7/7 (male)</p>
